Out-of-School Care

The Burnaby Association for Community Inclusion (BACI) operates two Out-of-School Care centres and two Child Care centres supporting children of all abilities in the Burnaby community. BACI has been providing child care services for over 20 years.

Our Out-of-School Care centres offer inclusive child care programs that strive for healthy and optimal growth and development for all children. Children are recognized as unique individuals with a variety of strengths, needs, talents and interests. We believe that children learn through play, curiosity, experimentation and exploration. Developmentally appropriate programming and activities are provided that promote inclusion, multiculturalism and learning.

The child-to-staff ratio for children in all-day Kindergarden and Grade 1 is 1 staff for every 10 children. For children in Grades 2 to 7, the ratio is 1 staff for every 15 children.

Hours of Operation

Our Out-of-School Care programs provide services Monday to Friday except on statutory holidays. The before-school hours are 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. After-school hours are 2:45 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. On professional days, Winter break and Spring break, the hours are 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

At both centres, services are offered:

- Full Time
- 3 days per week
- 2 days per week

Brentwood Park Plus (BPP) opened in 1990, and later moved to its own portable in September 1992. BPP is located on the East Side of Brentwood Park Elementary School. It is fully wheelchair accessible and is licensed to care for 20 children from 5 – 12 years old.

Licensed Programs

Our child care centres are licensed as group child care facilities by the Community Care Facilities Licensing Board and operate under the Provincial Child Care Facilities Regulations.

Staffing

Many staff are trained and certified in a variety of Community Support Programs such as Early Childhood Education. All staff are certified in First Aid and CPR, and have completed a Criminal Record Search.
