ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Infant Development Program (IDP) serves children from birth to three years old who are at risk for, or who already have, a delay in development. Our program brings parents and professionals together to help children overcome developmental difficulties. The program will continue to see your child until you no longer have concerns or your child has met their developmental milestones. Each Infant Development Consultant has skills and knowledge in child development, and can assist parents in enhancing their child's opportunity for development. All of our programs are “family-centred” meaning that you, the parent, decide what kind of support you need.



SERVICES AVAILABLE

Infant Development Program services include:

- Home visits to encourage progress, develop new activities and support parents
- Developmental assessments and written reports
- Various parent participation groups
- Therapy consultations
- Assistance for you and your child making transition to a preschool/childcare program
- Service coordination and referrals to other professionals and supports

WORKING WITH FAMILIES

Families play a vital role in every child's development. From birth to three years, a child develops at a rapid pace. Physical, social, emotional, behavioural, language and cognitive development depend in part on experiences provided by the infant's family. Once you are referred to the Program, you may come to any of our many groups and an IDP Consultant will visit with you and your child at home. An Infant Development Consultant will help you to plan activities that best meet your child's and family's needs.
