

1.14 Search Warrant Policy

A search warrant is a written order issued by a judge that allows the person holding the order – generally a law enforcement officer – to search a specific area for a particular piece of evidence related to a crime and/or legal investigation.

The Board of Directors, BACI employees, individuals receiving services, and volunteers (BACI representatives) must be fully cooperative when a legal search is executed on the premises of a property owned and/or operated by the Association.

BACI representatives will not participate in searches that do not meet legal requirements. The CEO must be immediately notified if a search warrant is issued.
